

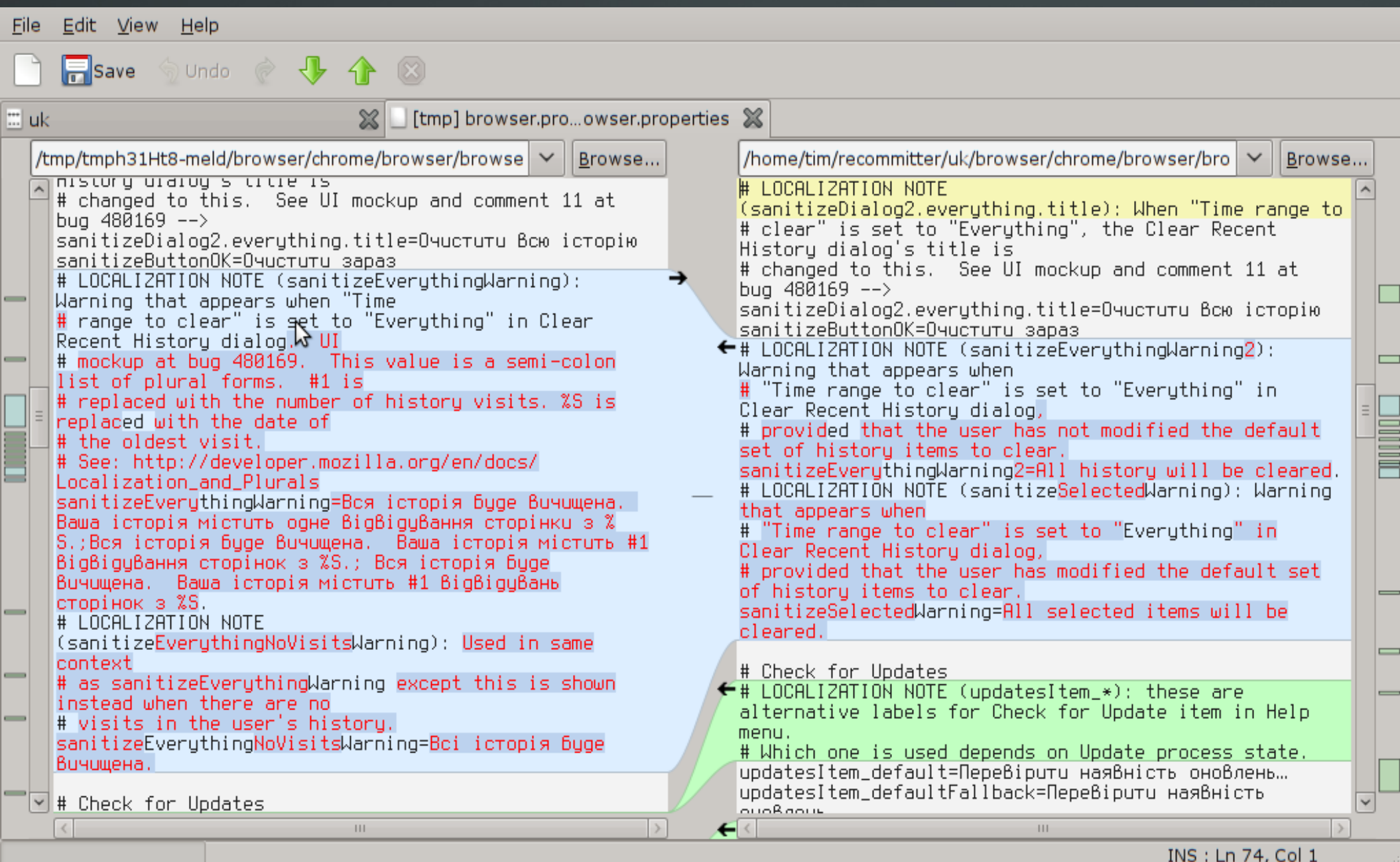
Silme+Mercurial

- Easy translation update
- Less work
- Nice GUI (Meld)

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Meld



Setup

- \en
- \your-locale
- silme.sh



Silme.sh

```
# patches my localization with English strings  
# fixes layout  
L=uk
```

```
mv $L/$1 $L/$1.presilme  
l10nmerge.py $L/$1.presilme/ en/$1/ $L/$1 --type 1
```



Usage examples

- silme.sh browser
cd your-locale
meld .
- silme.sh dom
meld your-locale
- silme.sh browser/chrome/browser



Installing

- Get Silme
hg clone http://hg.mozilla.org/users/zbraniecki_mozilla.com/silme
- Add its /scripts dir to your PATH
- Get Meld
- Save silme.sh
- Profit!



Tip

Add .hgignore :

```
syntax: glob  
*.presilme
```



Reverting

- Is easy, thanks to Mercurial
- `rm -rf dom`
(to forfeit files that might been added)
- `hg revert dom`
(or)
- `mv dom.presilme dom`
